ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- a) **Qualification:** Candidates should have passed the Diploma examination in Engineering/ Technology in the relevant branch of specialization conducted by the State Board of Technical Education, Tamil Nadu or any other equivalent examination recognized by Anna University.
- b) **Year of Qualifying for Diploma:** Candidates who have obtained the diploma in the relevant field before 01.01.2007 are eligible.
- c) **Employment:** Shall have been employed for at least one year after passing the entire subject in Diploma.
- d) **Place of work:** Candidates should be working in a place within a distance of 65 km from the University so as to enable him / her to attend the classes regularly by 6.15 p.m.

Marks and Selection Procedure

Marks for Qualifying Examination	- 70
Marks for Work Experience	- 30

Marks for Qualifying Examination

Weightage for the qualifying examination – 70 Marks to be calculated from the total marks obtained in the 5th (pre-final) and 6th (final) Semesters put together. In case of sandwich Diploma passed candidate marks secured in the last two semesters shall be considered. If the Industrial Training intervenes in any one of the last two semesters then the marks of the previous semester in which there is no Industrial Training shall be considered.

Marks for Experience

Weightage for the completed years of experience after passing the diploma examinations shall be fixed at a maximum of 30 marks in the following manner.

For every completed years of Service after one year of service - 3 Marks
Experience certificate issued by other than Government/Quasi Government Department should be accompanied with the following:

1. Employment/Sponsorship Certificate
2. Certificate of Registration under Companies Act. / SSI Registration Certificate.
3. TNGST Certificate/CST Certificate/TIN Certificate
4. Approved Contractors Certificate (Current) with I.T. Clearance Certificate for private individuals other than companies.

Work experience will be taken into account only if the Registration/Certificate Number of the companies are clearly mentioned.

Selection Procedure

A merit list will be prepared based on the total marks of 100 (Marks obtained in the qualifying examination reduced to 70 and marks awarded for work experience maximum of 30). In cases where more than one candidates have got the same marks in the common merit list, the inter-se merit among such candidates shall be determined in the order of priority as specified below:

1. Total year of experience
2. Total marks obtained in the pre-final and final semester put together
3. Date of Birth (Senior will be placed above)

Counselling will be done based on the merit and communal reservation.

The Candidates will be informed of their rank individually by post through the counseling call letter (Self addressed stamped envelope enclosed by the candidate). Rank list will also be published in Anna University Website. College and branch will be allotted only through counseling as per their rank following communal reservations. - a) Selection shall be made under five categories namely Open Competition, Backward Class Reservation, MBC&DNC Reservation, Scheduled Caste Reservation and Scheduled Tribe Reservation following the Rules of reservation of the Government of Tamil Nadu.

The candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu only will be considered for communal reservations and the list of communities eligible to compete against the reserved quota is appended (Annexure I).

- i) Candidates seeking admission against ST/SC/MBC & DNC/BC quota should obtain the certificates of social status in the prescribed **Permanent Community Cards from the competent authority in Tamil Nadu** and enclose attested copy of the same along with the application otherwise they will be considered under open category.

The ST candidates should obtain the Community Certificates only from the RDO of their native place or Collector of their districts or P.A. (General) to Collector of Chennai. The **Permanent Community Card** is issued to Scheduled Tribes by Tahsildars up to 11.11.89 is valid.

Community Certificates obtained from other than the respective district will not be considered and they will be treated under Open category.

- ii) Other State candidates working in Tamil Nadu will be considered under open competition only.

b) Special Reservation for Physically Challenged candidates is available as per Government Norms.

c) Any Course of study leading to B.E / B.Tech. (Part-Time) Degree Self-Supporting Programme of Anna University shall be offered only if the admission strength is equal to or more than 10.
