- 2) The person in charge of this program on the university side submits the application to NIMS Graduate Program Office by the deadline. Designated application form is provided.
- 3) Document Screening is made among all the applicants. NIMS Vice-President makes his/her judgment if the applicant shall be accepted or not.
- 4) The NIMS President gives a final approval of the student acceptance.
- 5) The administrative procedure, including Visa and accommodation arrangement in Tsukuba, shall be taken care of by NIMS.
