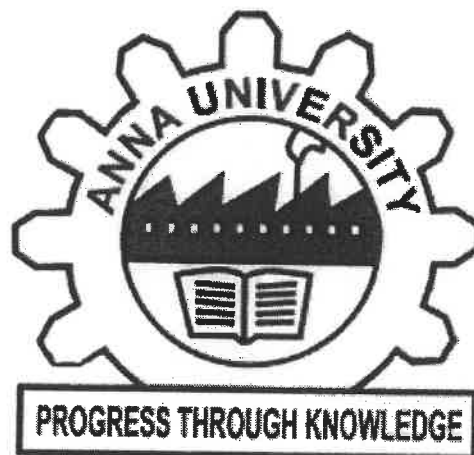

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into this _____ day of _____ 2016, between Temple University--Of the Commonwealth System of Higher Education ("Temple"), a comprehensive state-related research university located in 1801 N. Broad Street, Philadelphia, PA 19122, United States, and Anna University ("AU") a highly renowned University with affiliating status which offers higher education in Engineering Technology and allied sciences, with its principal place of business at Sardar Patel Road, Guindy, Chennai, Tamil Nadu, INDIA - 600 025, hereinafter referred to as Temple and AU.

The signatories agree:

ARTICLE 1:

1.1 TU and AU hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation that may be carried out in furtherance of the advancement of learning through the following activities as stated below:

- (a) Exchange of faculty and/or staff;
- (b) Exchange of graduate and/or undergraduate students;
- (c) Exchange of scientific materials, publications, and information;
- (d) Exchange of cultural activities;
- (e) Joint conferences and academic programs; and
- (f) Joint research activities and publications.

ARTICLE 2:

Both universities acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one university to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of the United States and India and shall comply with the regulations and policies of TU and AU.

ARTICLE 3:

Both universities agree students will be responsible for all expenses at the host university that are not covered by scholarships.

ARTICLE 4:

Both universities agree that all expenses, including research material, international and domestic travel, per diem, honoraria and all other costs for visiting faculty and researchers, shall be the responsibility of the home university or determined on a case-by-case basis and agreed to in writing by the parties prior to the visit.



ARTICLE 5:

Each side will make its best efforts to make available university accommodation to visiting faculty and students.

ARTICLE 6:

Both universities agree to review this Memorandum of Understanding after three (3) years' agreement period following the date of signing, and acknowledge that this Memorandum is subject to revision / termination at any time by mutual consent or by six months' written notice by either party.

ARTICLE 7:

Both universities agree that this Memorandum of Understanding is incorporated into, and will provide the foundation and framework for, projects developed by academic and administrative units from the two universities and documented in other subsequent Agreements.
