  - Faculty training

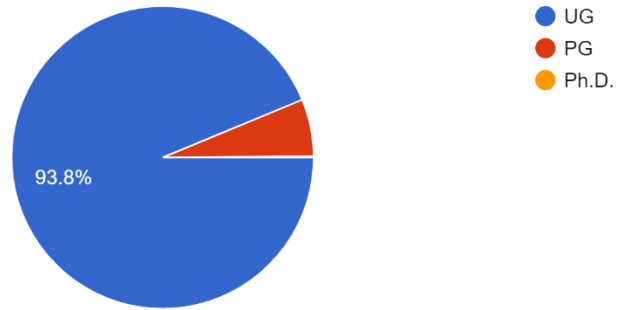

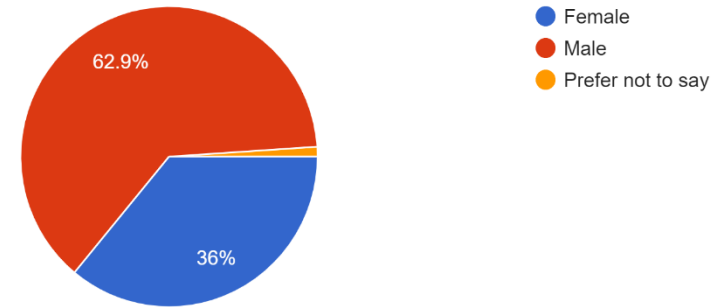
Student's Degree Program

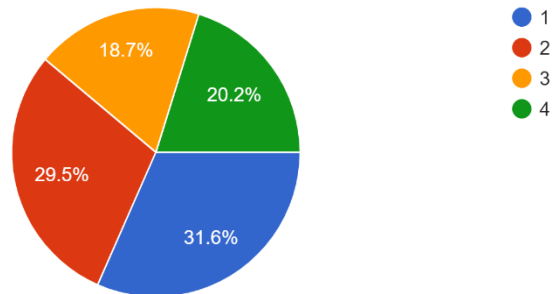
Gender

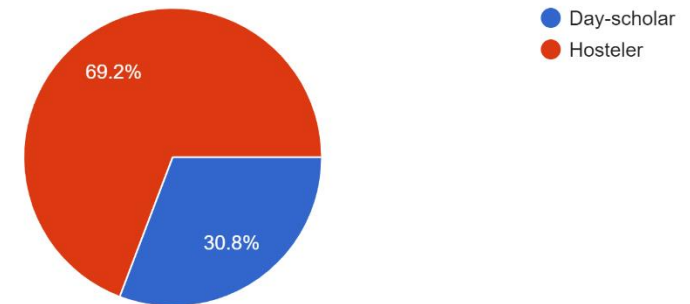
Student Current Year

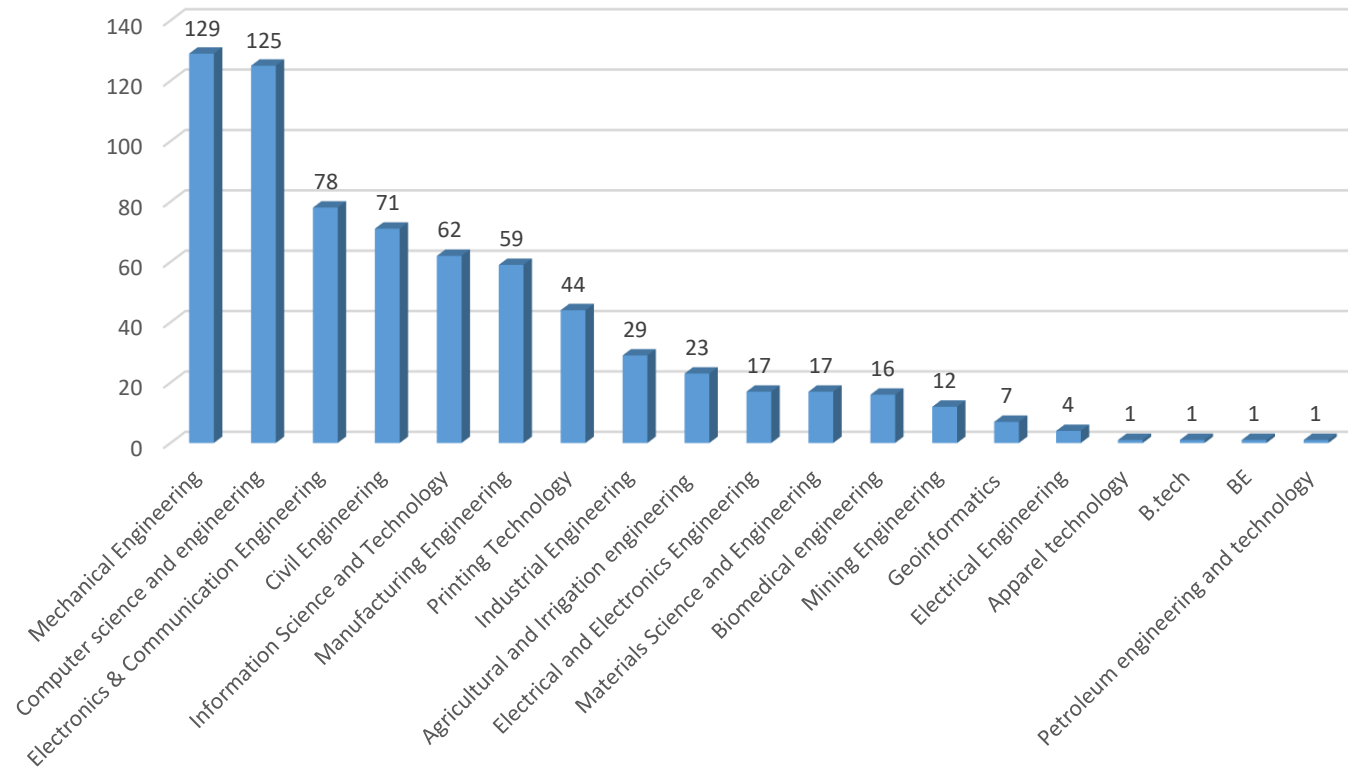

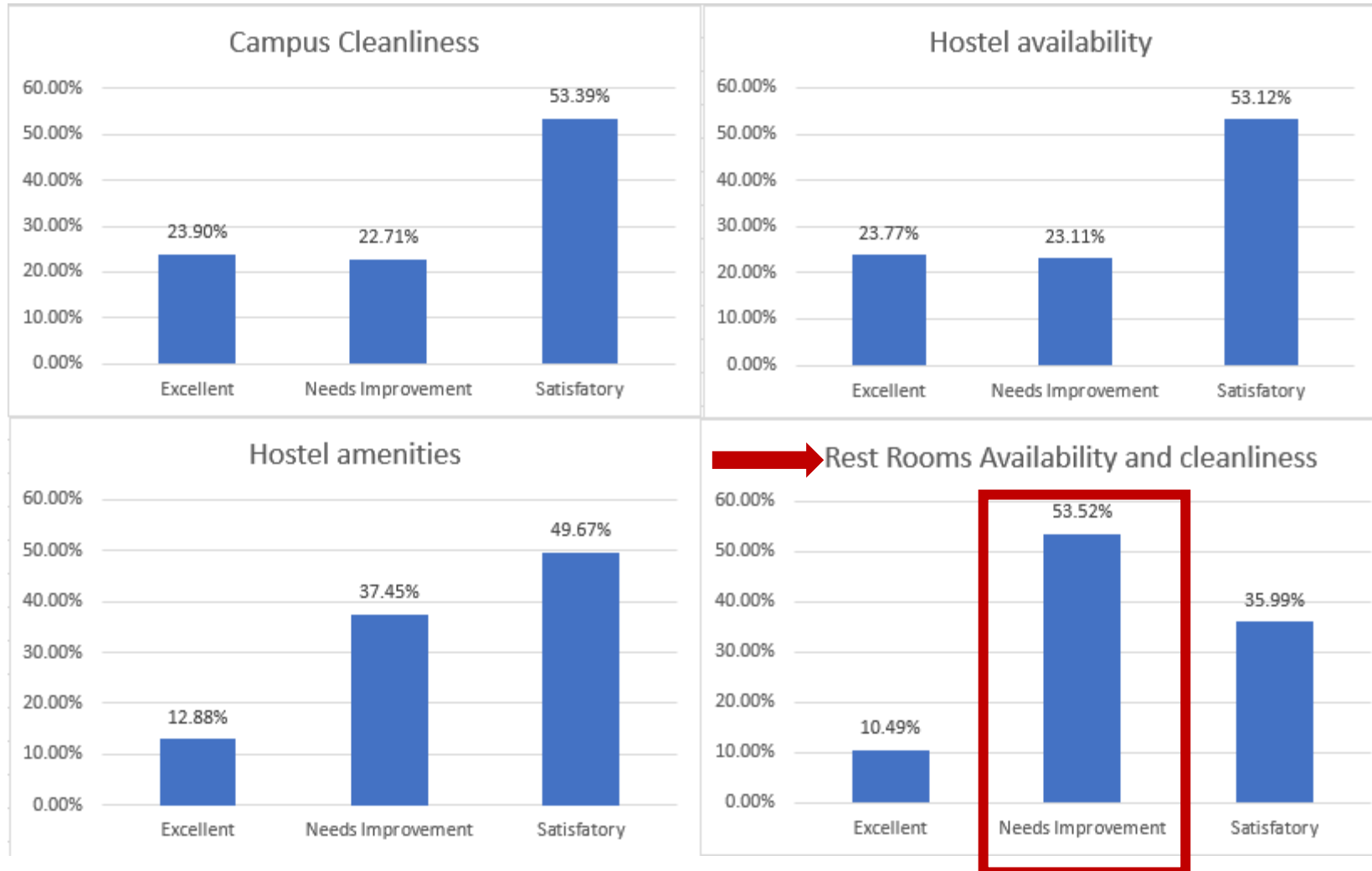

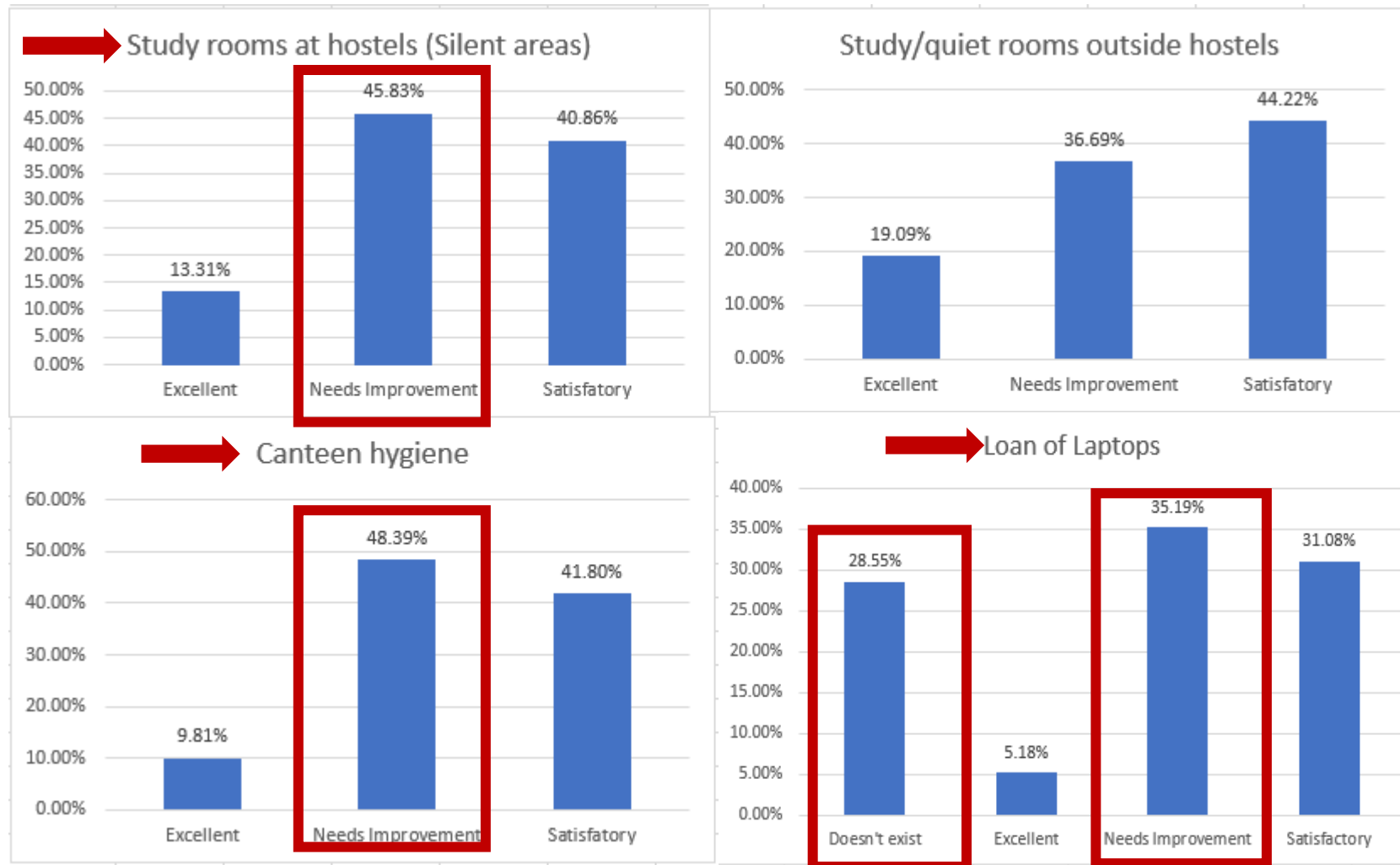
Count of Branch(Cleansed)

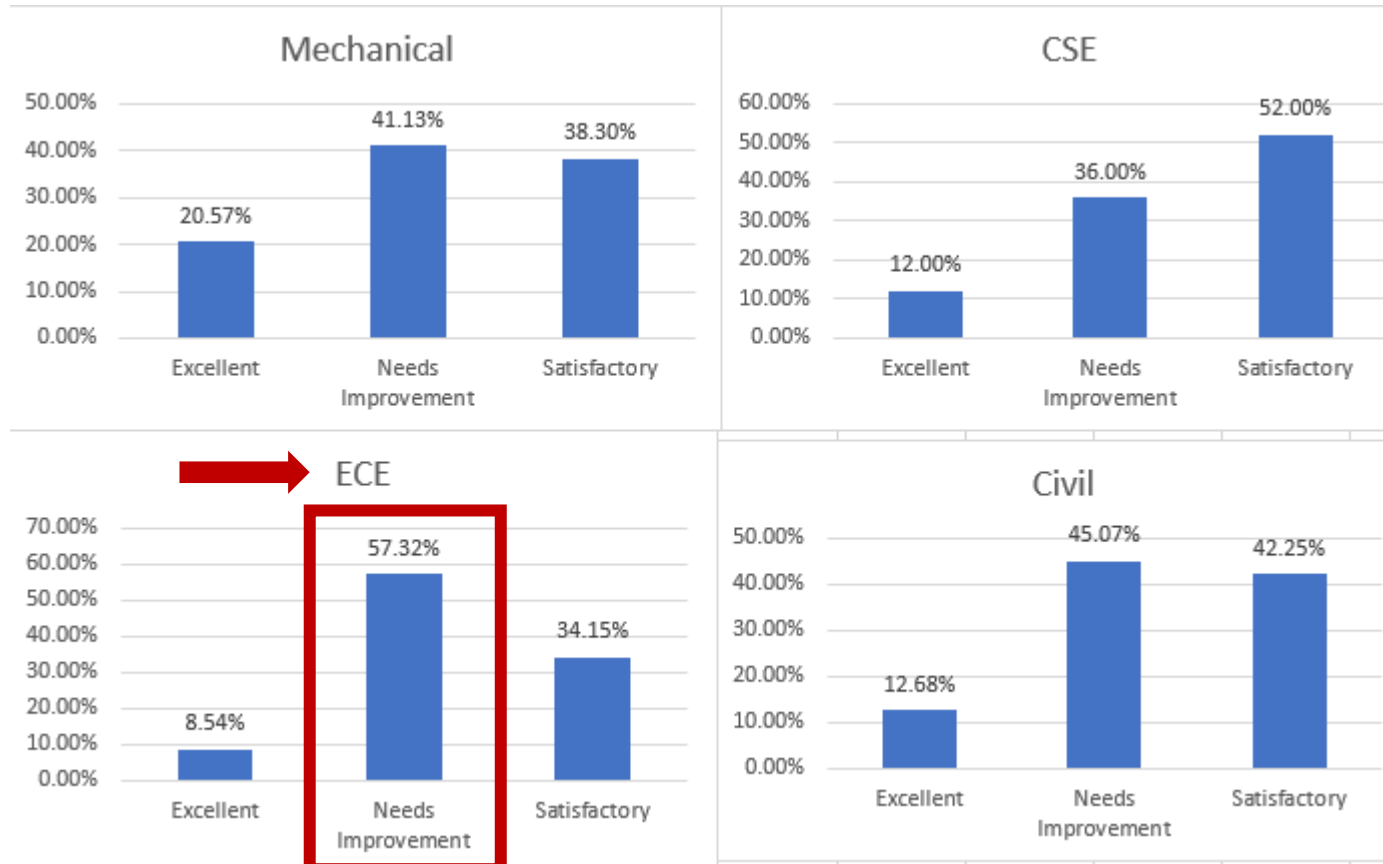

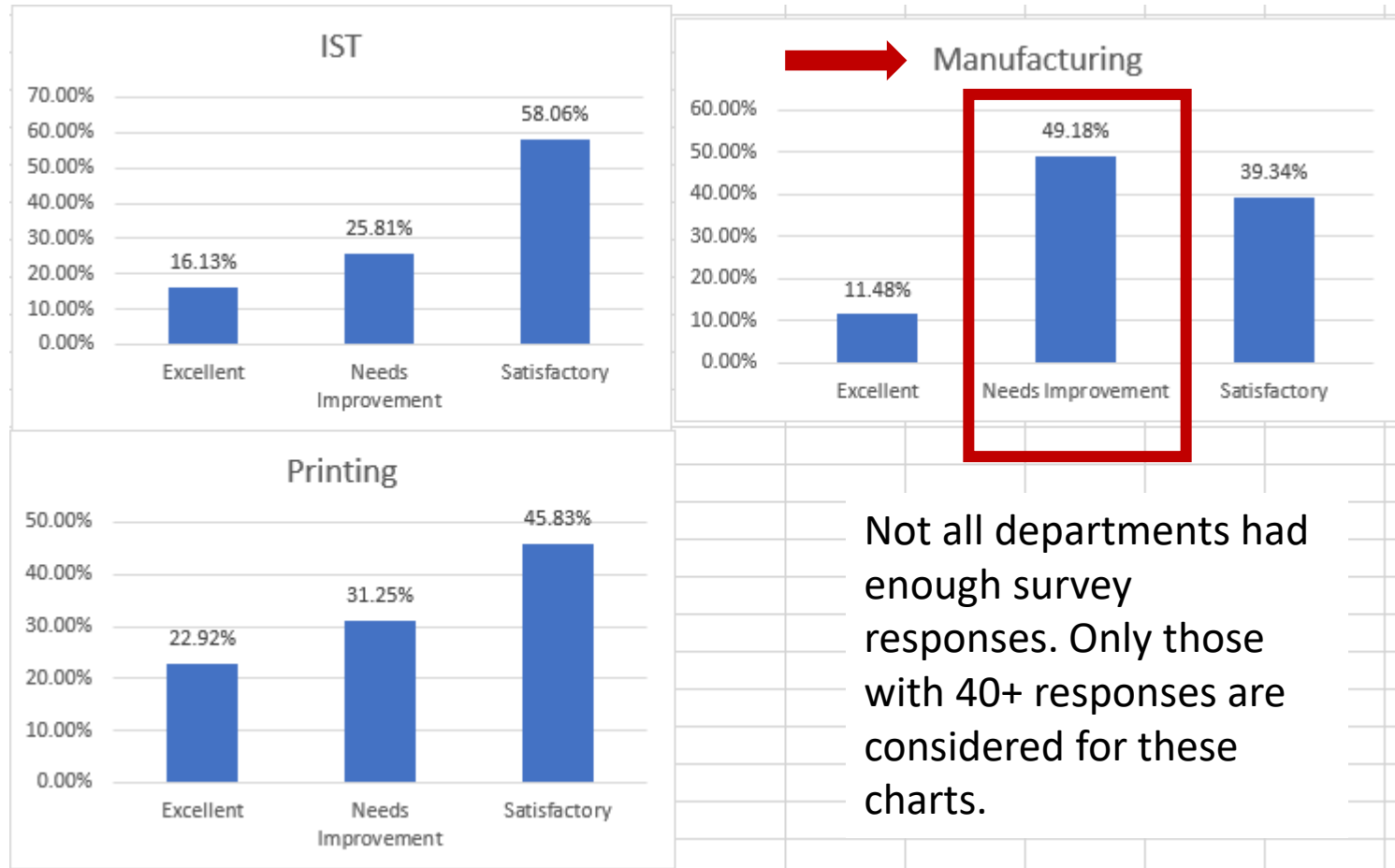
