Sub: Student Innovative Project - Call for proposals from 3rd year and 4th year Full time UG students in the University Departments / Centres / Institutes and Constituent Colleges - Intimation – Regarding.

The Centre for Sponsored Research and Consultancy calls for proposals for funding under Research Support Scheme – Student Innovative Project from 3rd year and 4th year Full time UG students in the University Departments / Centres / Institutes, Regional campuses and Constituent Colleges. The project duration is six months and the funding will be a maximum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Thousand only) to conduct the research work to develop a prototype process / product during the academic year 2025-2026.

The guidelines are displayed in the CSRC website and you are requested to disseminate the information to the students to submit the proposals based on their innovative ideas which will develop into prototype / process / product with the mentorship of regular faculty members.

To encourage interdisciplinary activity, they may be informed to join with students from other departments and submit joint proposals. The number of students for each project is to be a minimum of 2 and maximum of 3.

The faculty members, Head of the Departments / Directors of the Centres & Institutes are requested to inform the students and to display the enclosed brochure in the notice board and also to circulate among the students. The proposals are to be submitted through CSRC website and the hardcopy of the same shall be submitted through the Heads of Departments / Directors of the Centres & Institutes to CSRC. The last date for submission of the proposal through online mode is on or before **3rd September 2025**.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Any Full time UG Student in 5th Semester or 7th Semester of University Departments / Centres / Institutes, Regional campuses and Constituent colleges are eligible to apply.

2. A group of students (2 to 3 members) need to apply through a Mentor.

3. Students should submit only one proposals. Participation in multiple projects is not permitted.

4. The group shall apply under the mentorship of a Regular Faculty member in the University Departments / Centres / Institutes, Regional campuses and Constituent colleges.

5. Preference will be given to interdisciplinary innovative projects (Students coming from different branches).

Selection intimation to the students on or before : **12th September 2025**

Start Date of the Project : **22nd September 2025**

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

- ❖ The project proposal should aim to develop an innovative prototype / process / product.
- ❖ The proposal shall be submitted through online at CSRC - Anna University website (<http://ctdt.annauniv.edu/sip/>) on or before 30th August 2025.
- ❖ The PDF file generated after the online submission of the project has to be submitted to the CSRC duly forwarded by the respective HOD / Director / Deans (other than Main campus / MIT campus).
- ❖ The proposal shall contain the objectives, research methodology, deliverables and the budget requirement for developing the prototype product / component / system / process.

PROPOSAL SELECTION

- ❖ The students have to present their proposals before the committee.
- ❖ The screening of the projects will be done by the Expert Committee.
- ❖ The funds shall be utilized for the following purpose (Fabrication / purchase of instruments / units / equipment / components / spares, Travel by students, fees for conference registration (only for oral Paper presentation of this project in seminars / conferences - title of this project should be mentioned in registration fee receipt), Consumables, Contingencies.

PROJECT OUTCOME / DELIVERABLES

- ❖ The outcome of the project shall be an innovative prototype product / component / system / process.
- ❖ IPR arising out of the project will be jointly owned by the University and the Inventors. The Inventor shall be the students and mentor.
- ❖ The guidelines of Anna University with regard to Patent, Incubation, Technology Transfer and Startups will be applicable.

ABOUT STUDENT INNOVATIVE PROJECTS

Student Innovative Project is funded to the students of University Departments / Centres / Institutes, Constituent Colleges and its Regional Campuses for the development of a novel prototype product under Research Support Scheme of CSRC, Anna University. In this scheme, the innovative ideas are nurtured by providing funds to the tune of maximum of Rs.25,000/- per team.
