TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER AWARD

Successful design and / or development of product / process that has been transferred to the industry / client / user and is utilized by the them / society

INNOVATION AWARD

Design and development of a product / process / technique which is yet to reach the customer, but has the potential leading to commercial / socio-economic benefit.

DISTINGUISHED RESEARCHER AWARD

Contributions towards the sponsored research activities of the University during the period April 2016 – March 2021.

ACTIVE CONSULTANT AWARD

Active participation in the consultancy works and generating revenue for the University during the period April 2016 – March 2021.

RESEARCH EXCELLENCE AWARD

Research publications with Anna University Affiliation in Scopus Indexed Journals of more than 175 publications in category 1 & 100 publications in category 2.

Who can apply?

- Applicant should be a Regular Faculty member of Anna University.
- An applicant can be nominated under more than one category.
- Separate application should be sent for each nomination.

		* If an award goes to a team, each team member shall be given the memento and citation listing out the names of all team members and the cash award shall be shared among them.	
3.	Eligibility	<p>1. Faculty member(s) who are regular employees of the University and have carried out the work leading to Technology Transfer / innovation are eligible for nomination to the Technology Transfer / Innovation awards.</p> <p>2. Scientist(s) employed in projects / PPP Centers are eligible to apply to innovation awards only.</p> <p>3. Applicant(s) can be a single member or a team of members</p> <p>4. The period of claim for the award will be five academic years prior to the year of the award i.e. Technology Transfer/Innovation should have been carried out within a minimum five-year period (2016-2021).</p> <p>5. The work should have been carried out at the University with or without the support from industry or sponsoring agency.</p> <p>6. In case of multiple products / processes, applicant(s) can file more than one nomination for multiple products / processes.</p> <p>7. The Technology Transfer should have been made to industry /community and documented / certified by the industry or user community.</p>	
4.	Desirable	<p>1. Information about Patent(s) filed/granted for the Technology to be presented with evidence.</p> <p>2. The lead role played by the applicant for Technology Transfer through Interdisciplinary / inter institutional projects, if any, to be highlighted with evidence.</p> <p>3. Information about revenue generated to be given.</p>	
5	Application submission	The application should be filled through CSRC website and the online generated hardcopy of the application routed through HOD / Director should be sent to the Director, CSRC on or before 17 th September 2022.

Guidelines for Distinguished Researcher Award 2022

1.	Prize money	Rs. 25,000/- cash prize along with a citation and a memento.
4.	Eligibility & norms	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Distinguished Researcher award will be given for those who have proven their research capabilities by undertaking more research during the period April 2016 - March 2021.2. Nominations can be made based on self-nomination or by a professor of Anna University having more than ten years of experience. The nominations should be sent to Director CSRC through proper channel (Head of the Department / Director of the Centre or Institute / HOD and Dean of Regional offices / Constituent colleges).3. All permanent faculty members, excepting those who received Active Researcher Award earlier and who have completed the sponsored research projects in our University through CSRC during the last five years, till 31st March 2021, are eligible for nomination.4. Only projects sanctioned / received in the individual capacity as faculty members, based on the proposal submitted or request received should be included in the list of projects. Projects like FIST, DRS etc. which were sanctioned to the Departments / Centres in which the faculty members were appointed as coordinators need not be included.
5	Application submission	The application should be filled through CSRC website and the online generated hardcopy of the application alongwith the self-assessment sheet routed through HOD / Director should be sent to the Director, CSRC on or before 17 th September 2022.

Note: *The faculty members who were presented Distinguished Researcher award earlier (previously called Active Researcher Award) are not eligible for the nomination again in the same category.*

1.	Prize money	Rs. 25,000/- cash prize along with a citation and a memento.
2.	Eligibility & Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Active Consultant Award will be shortlisted based on the amount received through consultancy work.2. The Active Consultant Award will be shortlisted by Scrutiny Committee for the consultancy work undertaken during the period April 2016 - March 2021 based on the records with CSRC.3. The shortlisted faculty members will be intimated about their status through E-mail.4. The CSRC will inform the shortlisted candidates to apply for the final selection of consultancy award in the prescribed format to upload in CSRC website.

Note: *The faculty members who were presented with the award earlier are not eligible for the nomination again in the same category.*

Guidelines for Research Excellence Award 2022

1.	Prize & Eligibility	<p>Category 1:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Minimum 175 papers in Scopus Indexed Journals with cumulative impact factor of minimum 500.➤ h-index of minimum 40.➤ Citations of minimum 5000.➤ Cash prize of Rs. 30,000/-. <p>Category 2:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Minimum 100 papers in Scopus Indexed Journals with cumulative impact factor of minimum 300.➤ h-index of minimum 30.➤ Citations of more than 3000.➤ Cash prize of Rs. 20,000/-.
2.	Application format	<p>Provide the list of publications with “Title of the paper, Authors name, Affiliation, Name of the Journal, Vol.no, Year, Page number” (as per format given below) in the Scopus Indexed journals along with the first page reprint of research publication highlighting the title, author name, Affiliation, abstract and publisher details.</p> <p>Sample format:</p> <p>1. Performance of InGaN based cascade quantum well solar cells R. Ramesh, M. Gupta, S. Meena and K. Bala, Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering, College of Engineering Guindy, Anna University, Chennai 600025, India. IEEE Journal of Electron Devices Vol.208, (2019), PP2021-2025</p>
3.	Application submission	<p>The hard copy of the list of publications shall be sent to Director, CSRC and soft copy in PDF format by mail <directorctdt@gmail.com> on or before 17th September 2022.</p>
