CIRCULAR

James Cook University, Singapore is offering a 12 days **Immersion program** during 11 – 22 July 2022 for higher semester students at James Cook University, Singapore.

The approximate cost break-up for the program is as follows:

- Rs.1,46,000/- includes Program costs, Accommodation with breakfast, Daily fixed (travel + food) allowances. Excludes Flight Tickets & Visa Charges.
- 13-day stay in James Cook University, Singapore on two or three sharing basis.
- Food include breakfast, packed lunch and dinner.
- Passes will be provided for study related travel in public transport (train/bus) during stay at Singapore.
- Airport pickup and drop by bus on group service basis.
- Fee has to be paid to James Cook University nominated account in India.

Interested students of Anna University, Chennai (CEG, ACT, SAP and MIT campuses) can apply for this immersion program. Students can send their detailed applications forwarded from their Head of the Department to the Director, Centre for International Relations on or before **29th June 2022**. 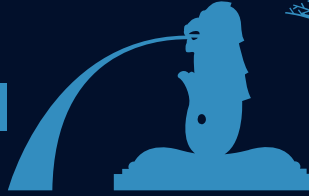
