Sub: AUSB – Additional Rules and Regulations for Sports Participation from 2017 -18 – Reg.

I am to inform you that the rules and regulations are to be followed as per the Anna University Sports Board Guidelines, for the participation of Zonal winning teams in the Inter Zonal Tournaments.

1. The Zonal winning teams from 1 to 19 Zones are informed to participate in the Anna University Inter Zonal tournaments. Failing which, the concerned zonal winning teams from the particular college will be debarred for one year in that particular game.
2. The College teams along with the Physical Director alone will be permitted to participate in the Anna University Tournaments / Selection Trails at all levels with duly filled – in Players Eligibility Proforma in all respects. In case of the emergency situation, the concerned College Principal has to depute a faculty from their college, with a requisition letter addressed to the Chairman, AUSB, extending a copy to the Local Sports Coordinator of a particular Sports Event.


