Introduction

The Youth Red Cross Special Camp 2025, conducted from 30th June to 6th July, was a week-long program dedicated to service, awareness, leadership development, and social responsibility. Held at **Somangalam Village** and coordinated by the YRC unit of **CEG CAMPUS**, the camp brought together student volunteers with a shared goal: to serve society while growing as individuals.

Each day of the camp was thoughtfully designed with a mix of community outreach, educational sessions, wellness activities, cultural expression, and teambuilding tasks. Volunteers engaged in teaching, health initiatives, rallies, environmental activities, creative workshops, and leadership talks.

Professionals, alumni, and faculty mentors contributed their knowledge, and the entire experience was marked by collaboration, enthusiasm, and commitment. This report provides a concise day-wise summary of the camp's major activities and outcomes.

# Day 1 – Inauguration & Orientation (30.06.2025)

The camp began with a formal inaugural ceremony, where volunteers were briefed on the objectives, expectations, and code of conduct for the week.

A Yoga and Wellness session was conducted by Mr. B. Venkatraman, laying the foundation for daily self-care, mindfulness, and energy. His guidance continued throughout the camp, setting a positive tone each morning.





Day 2 – School Service & First Aid Awareness (01.07.2025)

Volunteers performed community service activities:

➤ Team 1 taught Mathematics to students (Classes 6–9) at Somangalam GHSS.

- > Teams 2 & 3 cleaned the school campus.
- ➤ Teams 4 & 5 cleaned Arasu Sugathara Nilayam, encouraging hygiene awareness.

A First Aid Workshop was led by Mr. Tharun Murugesh, a certified Emergency Medical Trainer. The session covered CPR, bleeding control, burn treatment, and basic life support, with hands-on demonstrations.







Day 3 – Career Guidance & Fire Safety Demonstration (02.07.2025)

Volunteers conducted career guidance sessions at the school, with Mr. Dinesh Kumar (Career Trainer) providing motivational input and helping students explore career paths.

In the afternoon, a Fire Safety Demonstration was organized by the Tambaram Fire & Rescue Team, led by Mr. Ramesh (Station Officer). Students learned to operate fire extinguishers, handle emergencies, and react calmly under pressure.





Day 4 – Medical Camp, Tree Plantation & Motivation (03.07.2025)

This day focused on health, environment, and inspiration:

A Medical Camp was conducted with the support of Sai Ram Medical Team, offering basic check-ups and consultations to the villagers and Team 1 began preparations for a Drug Awareness Rally

Tree Plantation Drives were carried out:

- > 32 trees in the nearby cultivation area by Teams 2 & 5.
- ➤ 8 trees on the school campus by Team 2, guided by Principal Mr. Rajendran.

A motivational session by Mr. Solvendhan, Principal of Vendhan Alpha's Tutorial College, encouraged students to serve society with courage and compassion.

After his inspirational Tamil talk, Our Coordinator Dr.S.Thanigaiarasu shared his interest towards Tamil epic poems by sharing some lines from 'Kambaramayanam'.

In the evening, Team 3 performed a skit on social issues, balancing humour and awareness.





Day 5 – Heritage Educational Trip (04.07.2025)

Volunteers visited historical monuments at Mahabalipuram, including:

- Pancha Rathas
- Olakkannesvara Temple
- Mahabalipuram Lighthouse
- Shore Temple

This trip provided exposure to heritage, group bonding, and cultural learning. After the trip, Teams 1 & 4 continued skit rehearsals, while Teams 2, 3, and 5 organized group games for relaxation and team building.

### Day 6 – Alumni Interaction, Rally & Campfire (05.07.2025)

The day began with yoga, followed by creative skit performances:

Team 1: Dinner with the Ancestors – praised for creativity and emotional connection.

Team 4: Boys as Girls & Girls as Boys – appreciated for its humour and team coordination.

In the afternoon, YRC alumni – Mr. Santhosh, Mr. Jayasurya, Mr. Sudhakar, and Mr. Khailash – shared valuable insights and memories, inspiring the next generation of volunteers.

#### Newspaper castle:

A management game challenged teams to build castles using newspapers, demonstrating innovation and group synergy.

In the evening, volunteers conducted a rally in Somangalam Village on health, hygiene, and drug awareness, directly interacting with locals. The day concluded with the Flames of Friendship Campfire, full of music, dance, joy, and a heartfelt cake-cutting ceremony, celebrating the journey.





# Day 7 – Valediction Ceremony (06.07.2025)

The final day featured the Valediction Ceremony at VRR Hall, which began with Tamizhthai Vazhthu, YRC Song, and YRC Pledge.






