The Thulir Thiran Session was conducted on Thursday, 23rd October 2025. Students assembled sharply at 4.50 pm, and the event officially commenced at 05:00 pm with the singing of the YRC song and YRC Pledge.

Thulir Thiran event commenced with an introductory session highlighting the objectives and schedule of the day. The event featured six competitions – Singing, Drawing, Oration, Poem writing, Essay writing and Debate. The main theme for all the competitions was “*DR.A.P.J. Abdul kalam*”.

In the Drawing competition, participants portrayed inspiring moments from Dr. Kalam’s life history, achievements, and thoughts. The time allotted for this event was 30 minutes. 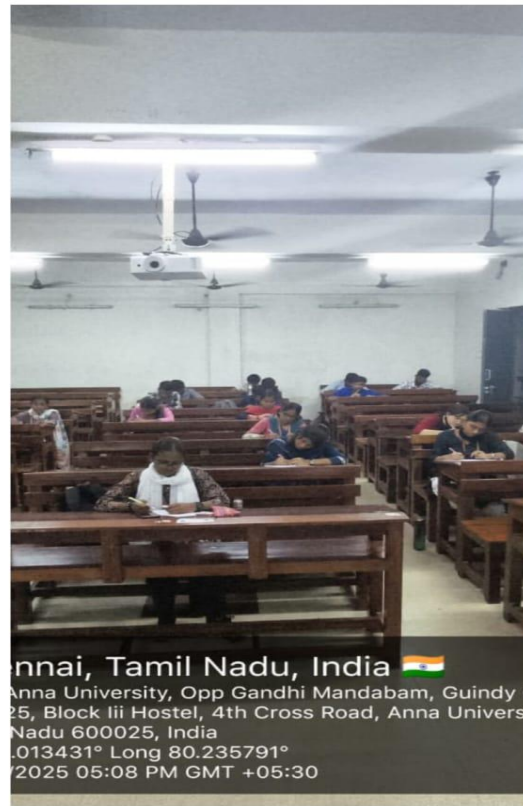
In the Poem competition and Essay competition events, participants expressed their ideas about Dr. Kalam’s vision and values with creativity
